“TRUSTING GOD TO TRY GOD TO FULFILL HIS VISION”

(A.)THE FULFILLMENT OF GOD’S VISION REQUIRES THE RIGHT WORKERS.

Exodus 36:1-2 KJV

(1)“The Lord has gifted Bezalel, Oholiab, and the other skilled craftsmen with wisdom and ability to perform any task involved in building the sanctuary. Let them construct and furnish the Tabernacle, just as the Lord has commanded.” (2)So Moses summoned Bezalel and Oholiab and all the others who were specially gifted by the Lord and were eager to get to work.

(B.)THE FULFILLMENT OF GOD’S VISION REQUIRES HIS WEALTH.

Exodus 36:3 KJV

Moses gave them the materials donated by the people of Israel as sacred offerings for the completion of the sanctuary. But the people continued to bring additional gifts each morning.

(C.)THE FULFILLMENT OF GOD’S VISION REQUIRES THE WILLING.

Exodus 36:4-5 KJV

(4)Finally the craftsmen who were working on the sanctuary left their work. (5)They went to Moses and reported, “The people have given more than enough materials to complete the job the Lord has commanded us to do!”

(D.)WHEN RIGHT WORKERS, GOD’S WEALTH, AND WILLING PEOPLE ALIGN WITH GOD’S VISION; GOD WILL SEND A WHOA.

Exodus 36:6 KJV

So Moses gave the command, and this message was sent throughout the camp: “Men and women, don’t prepare any more gifts for the sanctuary. We have enough!”So the people stopped bringing their sacred offerings.
